Scotland County is in for a scare this fall as ghouls, goblins, and some nasty clowns will descend on downtown Laurinburg. In what is quickly becoming one of the most popular annual events, Scotland County Parks and Recreation will again team with the Laurinburg/ Scotland County Chamber of Commerce to offer Insanitarium I8 – Nightmare on Main Street - a haunted house/ zombie tour for folks looking for a little fun, excitement....and scare.

The event will be held downtown – just off of Main Street at 116 Roper Street in Laurinburg. The “haunted building” will be open on the two weekends prior to Halloween -- Oct. 19, 20, 26, and 27 from 8:00 until midnight each night. The cost is \$10 per person.

The experience will be part haunted house, part block party, as food vendors and musical bands will entertain patrons on the outside, while scares and surprises await on the inside. “Fast Pass” that will allow patrons to avoid wait times and jump to the front of the haunted tour line.

Last year’s event was held out of town at the Old Wagram Prison. That site was not available this year, but organizers jumped at the opportunity to take over a whole building and to hold the event downtown – a move that offers customers considerable convenience and allows organizers to coordinate with downtown merchants and other events such as the Storytelling Festival of Carolina during the first weekend.

Members of the theater department at St Andrew’s University and UNC Pembroke along with community volunteers are creating the experience that they hope the public will have as much fun enjoying as they have had in organizing.
